Responding to issues in your community

During the month of November 2018 there was a total of 737 investigations in the East of Ipswich. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Criminal Offences recorded range from various assaults and public order offences to theft and burglary and drug possession.

Making the community safer

On 14th November Police together with partner agencies in Ipswich stopped 56 vehicles as part of Operation Drive Insured. Five arrests were made for drug drive and numerous fines were issued for traffic offences.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

In November Suffolk Constabulary pledged to support the White Ribbon Campaign 2018 aimed at putting a stop to Domestic Abuse. Talking to someone was seen as the first step. Contact the National Domestic Violence helpline 0808 2000 247 In an emergency dial 999

Fraud has become a common way for criminals to attempt to steal your money. Be aware of the different types of Fraud and current scams in your area. Police have been made aware of a phone scam in Felixstowe where someone purporting to be a Detective Constable investigating a Fraud has phoned up and remained on the line to gain personal details. Police will never phone you and request you bank details or ask you to send your bank cards with pin number in the post as part of any investigation.
