### WE DID...

1. A community event was carried out in Alderman Park where crime prevention advice was given out and regular patrols have been completed. Drug locations have been identified and work with the council and park patrol is ongoing in clearing these areas.
2. Key suspects have been identified with the help of the housing team and local businesses and the suspects have all been dealt with and educated about their behaviour.
- 3 Police have identified key suspects leading the ASB they have been arrested and prosecutions are pending. A Police Surgery was carried out in Garrick Way and further work will be completed from these findings.

## FURTHER INFORMATION

**BRIDGE** 100 reported crimes

Two daytime dwelling burglaries reported cash and electrical items stolen. There has been 6 theft from motor vehicles where cash has been targeted (please make sure you remove valuables from vehicles and make sure that they are locked)

**GIPPING** 154 reported crimes

6 dwelling burglaries Cash electrical items and tools stolen a mixture of nighttime and daytime.. Five theft from motor vehicles. Two class A possession offences, suspects have been arrested and have been processed by police. One robbery cash and mobile phone targeted.

**STOKE PARK** 79 reported crimes

Three dwelling burglaries daytime crime when occupants were not present. Three theft from motor vehicles again targeting cash left in the vehicles. Two theft of motor vehicles.

**SPRITES** 64 reported crimes

Two dwelling burglaries daytime crime. Two theft from motor vehicles. Crime of note distraction burglary please be vigilant for people attending elderly occupants addresses that do not look legitimate and report any suspicious persons who appear to be targeting these addresses.

**CASTLE HILL** 86 reported crimes

Eleven theft from motor vehicles and 3 theft of motor vehicles. One Dwelling Burglary and one Aggravated Burglary (Domestic related)

**WHITEHOUSE** 104 reported crimes

Three Dwelling Burglaries daytime crimes. Seven theft from motor vehicles. Four theft of motor vehicles. Three reported Robberies, three suspects have been identified and have been arrested a lot of work being carried out with regards to these suspects to prevent further crimes from these males who appear linked to the ASB in the Whitehouse area.
