WE DID...

1. The West SNT have continued to patrol the area of Hawthorn Drive and given reassurance to the public and businesses, A joint meeting between the police and local businesses has been undertaken to put in some measures to stop the ASB that has been occurring. Local SNT have been out on patrols around the schools to offer reassurance during the peak school drop of and pick up times.
2. The Area of Burlington road has been patrolled and people who have been found to be partaking in drug activity have been dealt with, The SNT are still patrolling and monitoring this area
3. The SNT have been patrolling around the area of Cambridge drive due to reports of young youths running and jumping onto garages and bin stores, A joint effort with the SNT and local schools have identified the offenders and have been spoken to.

There has been 58 crimes reported in the Whitton area. There has been an decrease in criminal damage offenses in this area. Police have made arrested in relation to damage to vehicles. There has been a few theft from motor vehicle, please make sure all valuables are removed from your vehicle and check to make sure your vehicle is locked by checking the handle on the doors.

Whitehouse

There has been 103 Crimes reported to the police, The police have charged a male with breaching their criminal behaviour order for wasting police time. There has been a decrease in ASB crimes and criminal damages crimes.

Castle hill.

36 crimes have been reported to the Police in the Castle Hill area, There has been a few ASB crimes reported to the police, where names have been given to the police and have taken action on them. please keep an eye out and if you see or hear anything out of the ordinary please call 101 or 999 if something is happening at the time

Bridge.

112 Crimes have been recored. there has been a number of criminal damage to dwellings and vehicles, there has been a number of suspects interviewed for some of these crimes. There has been a few successful warrants executed in the Bridge area.

Stoke park.

109 Crimes have been reported to the Police, There has been only one report of ASB reported to the police. There has been a few reports of Assaults with a number of arrested made in relation to these assaults. There has been a few criminal damage to dwellings and vehicles, with one offender receiving a youth caution, and another offender being named.

Sprites.

62 Crimes were reported to the Police. There again has only been one ASB report to the police. There has been a few reports of criminal damage to dwellings with one named offender and the others are on going investigations. There has also been a number of common assaults reported, one named offender, another has received a community resolution.

There has been a number of successful warrants undertaking in the Sprites area, with a cannibus factory taken down and a arrest made.

The effectiveness of investing in home security has recently been highlighted in Bury St Edmund's in an attempted burglary that has resulted in the arrest of a prolific burglar. The home owner in question had fitted a video enabled door bell. This sent a message to his phone alerting them that someone was at the his door of his house and streamed a video of the person, in this case trying to break in.
