Responding to issues in your community

During December and January, there has been an increase in burglaries to commercial premises in coastal towns. Whilst the majority of these have been in Southwold others have occurred in Aldeburgh.

Whilst these crimes are being investigated our team have been visiting all the town centre businesses to offer crime prevention advice. Businesses are being advised to make sure any cash is removed from the store overnight. Patrols during the evening hours have increased so that extra attention is given to the area.

Making the community safer

Officers for your SNT and other partner agencies have visited Alde Valley School to assist SCDC in delivering the Crucial Crew Program. The day provided short impressive talks for students in years 7 to 11 focusing on education to keep them safe. Subjects discussed included Healthy Relationships, Online Crime, Sexual Consent and Gang Groups. The feedback from both the school and students was that it was a valuable and well received day for all.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

A group of youths are being investigated for trespassing on a railway line. British Transport Police will be showing an educational safety video to educate them on the dangers involved.

Street Pastors in Leiston continue to patrol the streets of Leiston at weekends. They are being well received by residents and continue to support people suffering from drink related issues, and making their way home.
