In the month of May your SNT has been dealing with wider issues within the community, such as mental health, domestic violence follow ups, youth work with local schools and youth clubs, Anti Social Behaviour (ASB), vulnerable people (including the chronically excluded), licensing issues at both on and off licenses. As well as all of this the SNT has responded to complaints from the general public in relation to speeding, parking, dog incidents and neighbour disputes.

This allows the response teams to focus solely on emergency calls to improve the efficiency of the organisation as a whole.
