## Leiston

### You said...

Parking outside local primary schools causing problems at start and end of school day.

Illegal Parking in Aldeburgh is on the rise now that Spring has arrived. Concerns are that this will get worse as the Summer approaches.

### We did...

We monitored parking outside Leiston Primary, Coldfair Green Primary, Knodishall and Robert Hitcham Primary, Framlingham. Schools were also asked to reissue an SNT warning letter, regarding responsible parking, as a reminder for the parents/guardians of pupils.

Patrols to increase in Aldeburgh High Street to target parking and obstruction offences.

### Responding to issues in your community

Framlingham Gala Weekend went very smoothly and was enjoyed by all who came along on, what was, a very sunny and warm weekend. We are pleased to say that everyone behaved themselves and no arrests or anti-social behaviour occurred.

A meeting with the organisers and participating agencies from the Leiston 'Pop Up, Pop In' community event was held, and the consensus was that something similar, on a smaller scale, maybe in the evenings and a weekend, would be worthwhile and catch a greater number of people.

### Making the community safer

There was an incident in Old Foundry Place in Leiston and, as a result, one male has been arrested and charged. To reassure residents in the town, the Constabulary has increased its patrols in the area.

During the Winter there were a number of commercial burglaries in Aldeburgh and Leiston, which were linked to those in Southwold. The identified offender has now been arrested and charged for these offences.

### Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

A Police Officer was injured whilst in Aldeburgh by a hit and run rider on a motorcycle. The Officer's leg was injured and he was taken to hospital. Two males have been arrested for this incident. The Constabulary would like to thank those who came forward to support the injured officer.

We have dealt with a number of neighbour disputes this month. Examples include an ongoing boundary dispute which also involved potential criminal damage and harassment issues. Another was when a male went into an elderly lady's garden at night looking for his pet cat, without informing her, causing her concern and anxiety when she saw him there. Words of advice given to the male. Another was where neighbours in a small block of flats were in disagreement over parking spaces.
