Reports have come in of Theft and Damage to Sheds on Allotments near Water Lane Lowestoft, Crime prevention advice has gone out to local residents to prevent further loss or damage and the Safer Neighborhood Team will be working closely with local residents to prevent further issues and will look to increase patrols in this area assisted by the Neighbourhood Response Team "NRT".
