Making the community safer

Due to an increase in ASB by youths on Red Lodge, the SNT will be carrying out targeted high visibility patrols during the evenings around the hot spots identified. Police recently carried out a search of a property in Tuddenham where a quantity of drugs and weapons have been seized. The investigation is ongoing.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

Following an increase in ASB on St Johns Estate the team engaged with residents and identified two young persons. They have now been involved in diversionary work with Young People Services and incidents have reduced.
