# NEWBORN BABY FOUND

## CAN YOU HELP?

**On 14 May the body of a newborn baby girl was tragically found at the Sackers recycling centre, Needham Market. Since then, we have been trying to identify her but we need help from the public.**

We believe this newborn baby girl was placed into a commercial bin at one of 52 waste pick-up locations. She was left there before being collected by a waste collection lorry on Thursday 14 May. It is likely the baby girl was placed into the bin on 13 or 14 May.

We are appealing to anyone who may have seen anything unusual or have any information, however limited, to come forward.

It may be difficult to come forward with information, particularly if you have concerns about a family member or friend, but if you know who this baby girl is and how she came to be placed into a bin, please come forward and help us as soon as possible.
