Responding to issues in your community

Cycle thefts continue to be an issue. We have been working to raise awareness of ways that you can protect your pedal cycle and hopefully avoid the theft of your pride and joy.

We have been promoting work with other agencies to address the concerns raised over Homeless people and those begging in the town centre. These issues will not be fixed over night however we are working with partners to develop a strategy to improve the situation.

Making the community safer

We continue to work with other teams from the constabulary to address concerns from the community around violent crime.

There have been numerous calls surrounding incidents of ASB within the area of St Clements Church. We have worked hard with the council to address these issues and recently a new CCTV camera has been installed in the area and we are already seeing an improvement.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

We received reports from residents in area of Bramley Hill that they were experiencing problems with anti-social behaviour from groups of youths. Resources were allocated to the areas identified and the groups engaged with by officers. Parents were spoken to and expectations outlined around appropriate behaviour. We have received feedback from residents that any issues have significantly reduced.
