In addition to the issues reported to us above we have dealt with a number of other neighborhood concerns and local issues. My officers have been out linking in with schools to offer inputs on various subjects such as staying safe in the community, road safety, the dangers of substance abuse and safe use of the Internet and social media. Linking in with mental health teams and care homes in order to safeguard vulnerable people within our community/ They have also been conducting a great deal of work on reducing areas of anti social behavior particularly in regard to some acts of criminal damage.
