Following concerns raised by the local community, we have recently had successful approval for a Community Speed Watch (CSW) site on Woodbridge Road near to St Helen's primary School.

7 volunteers have undergone training provided by our staff and we hope to get the first deployment out on the street soon. This is really good news, and will hopefully see motorists take a more responsible approach to their speed and driving near to the school.

We have recently been part of some really positive meetings with businesses and residents in both Norwich Road and St Helen's Street.

These meetings have resulted in the localities coming together to create area focused forums, which have the support of their Councillors and the aim of raising the profiles of these often forgotten locations.

Winter Night Shelter

The Winter Night Shelter scheme comes to an end mid March.


This has been a multi agency and partnership scheme to provide a warm bed and meal for those who would have otherwise found themselves sleeping rough or sofa surfing over the colder months.

Our local Churches and the numerous local charities involved have done some tremendous work since November and this has seen 14 people provided with accommodation who otherwise would have returned to the streets.
