FURTHER INFORMATION

Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself as the new Sergeant covering Hadleigh SNT which includes the 49 villages listed at the end of this newsletter. I started my policing career in 2005 and was based at Sudbury police station for 4 years. In 2009 I requested a move to the tutor unit which was based in Ipswich and spent the next year and a half tutoring the new recruits. From here I then joined the Ipswich Response team until I got promoted in November 2012. I was posted to Haverhill where I spent 2 months before another move to the Night Time Economy Team which was based in Ipswich but covered the whole of the county. I specialised in Alcohol Related Disorder across the county and had a close working relationship with Licensed premises across Suffolk. In 2014 the team evolved into the Pro-Active Licensing Team which I managed until January 2016 when I went onto Maternity Leave. I returned to Hadleigh Safer Neighbourhood Team in February 2017 and am really excited about the new challenge that comes with community policing. I have been provided with a comprehensive handover from Sergeant Millbourne on the excellent work which has taken place in the past year and the current policing priorities which the team are focussing on.

Following a series of burglaries in the Pinewood area a male was arrested on 1st February on suspicion of conspiracy to burgle. The male has been bailed to appear at Martlesham Police Investigation Centre on 24th March.

There was a series of burglaries in the Holbrook area which included home, shed and garage burglaries. A male has been arrested and charged with two burglaries, common assault and assault on police.

I would be keen to hear from any members of the community with any police related issues which they wish to discuss and will be attending the next Parish Forum meeting on 15th March. In the meantime I can be contacted via phone on 101 or e-mail the team at HadleighSNT@suffolk.pnn.police.uk.
