WE DID...

*A PcsO match funded post has been secured and is dedicated to Centre Parcs. PcsO Chittock has been carrying out high visibility patrols and meeting with staff to discuss crime prevention on site. To date he has recovered several missing bike and returned them to their owners. 4 youths have also been dealt with by Community Resolution for illegal entry on the Centre Parcs site.

FURTHER INFORMATION

It appears not all Parish Councils are aware of the National Police Crime Data website run by the Home Office. It's been in existence for some years and is owned and publicized by the Home Office. It contains all your local crime data, stop search data and other similar information. During the implementation of the Suffolk Local Policing Review this information was shared at SALC meetings but we thought we would take this opportunity to remind parish and town councilors of its existence.

If you wish to review the crimes reported in your parish you should go to the National Police website (www.police.uk) and select:

- Crime map
- Enter your Post Code and drill down as necessary to your local parish.

Between 1st July - 31st July 2016 there have been 102 investigations recorded within the 4 wards that make up Brandon SNT area. The majority of investigation recorded come under Burglary/Theft, Assaultive behavior - GBH, ABH, Common assault with or without injury, Criminal Damage, Vulnerable Adult and Child referrals to our specialist department.

FURTHER INFORMATION

PROPERTY MARKING:

There are a number of ways of security marking your valuables to protect them against theft and assist police to return them to you if they have been recovered. These include Ultra violet (UV) or invisible marking, Engraving or etching, Ceramic marking or Forensics marking solutions as offered by firms such as Smartwater (www.smartwater.com) and Selectadna (www.selectadna.co.uk).

Photograph your valuables - Photographs should be taken against a plain background and include a ruler to give an idea of size.

Close it, Lock it, Check it – Open windows can be seen as opportunities for burglars. Please ensure that downstairs windows and other ones vulnerable to entry are shut. When leaving home check that all windows have been shut and locked.

Review your home security regularly – We suggest you look at the Secured by design – www.securedbydesign.com – for Police approved supplies of everything from Door locks to fencing to intruder alarms.

Cyber Crime – Get Safe Online at www.getsafeonline.org/norfolksuffolk has advice on personal and business Internet use including safeguarding children, physical protection of smart phones and tablets. It also has info on the different types of Internet fraud, how to protect your Internet connection and much more.
