FURTHER INFORMATION

Brandon Safer Neighbourhood Team area has had 97 investigations recorded during June. Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into child and adult protection (safeguarding), mental health and anti social behavior.

Brandon East has had 42 investigations recorded; these have included theft, assault, public order, burglary, drugs, sexual offenses and a number of safeguarding investigations.

Brandon West has had 13 investigations recorded; these have included theft, damage, burglary, malicious communications, domestic abuse and a number of safeguarding investigations.

Lakenheath has had 11 investigation recorded; these have included theft, assault, damage, malicious communications, stalking and a number of safeguarding investigations.

Eriswell & The Rows has had 24 investigation recorded; these have included theft, assault, damage, burglary, domestic abuse along with a number of safeguarding investigations.

Across the Forest Heath Locality area there has been an increase in burglary offenses whether dwelling (homes) or non dwelling (sheds, garages or commercial premises). Suffolk overall has one of the lowest burglary rates in the Country and by following the points below we can all make a help to make it even safer

- *Ensure doors and windows are locked-even if you are popping out for a minute
- *Fit key operated locks to windows
- *Ensure garden tools and ladders are locked away
- *Lock your shed and garage
- *Timer switches can be used to switch lights/radios on and off to make your home appear occupied
- *Security mark your valuables with your postcode (Contact your local SNT for free marking equipment)
- *Do not keep large amounts of money in your home

"Now that the new model of delivering your local policing is 3 months old we wanted to remind you of the many ways you can get in touch with us. Most importantly, if it's an emergency always ring 999. However, if it's not an emergency but you wish to report a crime or a concern for safety then use 101. If you simply wish to contact your local team, perhaps to tell us about Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) or a series of crimes occurring in your area, or to tell us about your concerns about how the police have handled a local community matter, why not in the first instance speak with your local Inspector and discuss the matter with them?

Your local Inspector will be able to review the matter and make an assessment about how well we did, reporting back to you with their findings. Your local community inspector is Inspector Mark Shipton

If you want to speak to your local officer and it's not urgent then an email will be quickest means to get in contact, and if you need a reply then a member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs.

Remember, the demand on 101 is very high and if you don't need to report a crime we would encourage the use of email.
