## FURTHER INFORMATION

Brandon Safer Neighbourhood Team area has had 145 investigations recorded during May. Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into:

Safeguarding individuals and intelligence reports. In the near future we hope to be able to provide more detailed crime statistics.

The majority of investigations recorded come under Burglary/Theft, Assaultive behavior - GBH, ABH, Common assault with or without injury and Vulnerable Adult and Child referrals to our specialist department.

Brandon East has had 48 investigations recorded; 15 of these have been theft related, with the remainder being made up from Criminal Damage, Domestic Abuse related incidents, assaults with or without injury and Safeguarding referrals.

Brandon West has had 21 investigations recorded of which 8 have been burglary/theft related particular to Centre Parcs. The remainder being made up of ASB, Public Order, Domestic Abuse related and Safeguarding referrals.

Lakenheath has had 31 investigation recorded; Between 6th - 10th May 7 thefts of Catalytic Converts has occurred within the village. The remainder being made up of Assaults with or without injury and Safeguarding referrals.

Eriswell & The Rows has had 45 investigation recorded; 7 of these have been full or attempted Burglaries on the RAF Lakenheath base housing. Offenders have targeted premises being renovated and removed heating systems from within. The remainder are made up from Theft, Criminal Damage, Assault with or without injury, ASB, Domestic Abuse and Adult/Child Safeguarding referrals.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

Suffolk Constabulary are keenly aware that we have not published any crime and event data in April, May and now June. The reasons for this revolve around our ICT system which has not been performing as we would have wanted recently and we cannot currently guarantee the accuracy of the data we might publish. We have therefore made the decision not to publish data at this time rather than publish misleading data and misrepresent the true situation, either positively or negatively. We know this is frustrating for communities. Our ICT team are working very hard to rectify this situation and have given assurances the situation will soon be resolved. Sorting this out is a priority for us and we offer our apologies at this time for the situation. When it is rectified we will be able to publish both current and historic (i.e. April/May + June) data as required. We hope normal service will soon be restored!
