FUTURE EVENTS

SNT officers will be attending engagements (subject to operational commitments) with: Mildenhall police cadets on 6th, 13th, 20th & 27th May, dedicated town centre patrols in Brandon on 4th & 25th May, Surgery at Brandon day care centre 23rd May. In addition licensing checks, speed enforcement and parking issues will be addressed across the area during the month, targeted by way of intelligence.



FURTHER INFORMATION

Between 1st - 30th April 2017 there have been 347 incidents and 177 investigations within the 4 wards that make up the Brandon SNT area. Many of the investigations relate to theft, criminal damage, public order along with adult/child and mental health referrals. Figures below relate to crime categories from the Police and Crime Plan only.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Figures for both March and April have shown increases in theft from motor vehicle so we would urge people to read the following crime reduction advice previously published on our April newsletter.

Vehicle owners should follow the following advice:

- Don't leave anything on display in your car - even a plastic bag can be enticing to a criminal
- Take your car keys to bed with you. Lock all your home doors and windows.
- Take your belongings with you when you leave the car - if you can't, lock them in the boot before you start your journey
- Fit an electronic immobiliser- this will prevent the car from starting
- Mechanical immobilisers, such as steering wheel locks, are a good alternative to electronic immobilisers
- Fit locking wheel nuts
- Get an alarm installed
- Mark all your valuables that you frequently take in your car
- Lock all doors and close windows and the sun roof every time you leave your car unattended
- If you have a garage, use it. If you not always try and park in a well lit open place
