FURTHER INFORMATION

Between 1st - 31th October 2016 there have been 283 incidents and 131 investigations within the 4 wards that make up Beck Row, Brandon, Lakenheath, Santon Downham, Elvedon and Eriswell Parishes.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR WARD 1ST - 31 October 2016

Brandon West

There have been 19 investigations recorded which consist of 2 assaults, 1 drug offence. The remainder are theft type offenses, criminal damage, harassment, public order and vulnerable child and adult referrals.

Brandon East

There have been 63 investigations recorded which consist of 10 assaults, 1 dwelling burglary and 1 sex offence. The remainder consist of theft type offenses, criminal damage, public order, possession of offensive weapons and vulnerable child and adult referrals.

Eriswell & the Rows

There have been 36 investigations recorded which consist of 8 assaults and 1 dwelling burglary. The remainder consist of theft type offenses, criminal damage and vulnerable child and adult referrals.

Lakenheath

There have been 18 investigations recorded which consist of 3 assaults and a dwelling burglary. the remainder consist of theft type offenses, a road traffic offence, public order and vulnerable child and adult referrals.

FURTHER INFORMATION

There has been a rise in the number of theft from motor vehicles during October particularly targeting Catalytic Converters. Our offenders prefer to work in the quiet hours and are specifically targeting Honda's. There is quite a big market for catalytic converters and whilst we work to build up the intelligence picture around this specific crime series we are urging the public to be alert to this crime and take preventative measures to secure your vehicle, especially if it is a Honda. Please see the below advice:

Police are warning all vehicle owners that there has been a series of recent thefts of catalytic converters in areas of West Suffolk - including Eriswell, Lakenheath, Bury St Edmunds, Red Lodge, and Haverhill. Commercial vehicles and 4 wheel drives are particularly at risk because the higher ground clearance allows easier access for the criminals who target them.

To reduce the likelihood of becoming a victim:

- Garage your car whenever possible
- Park in well-lit, busy areas
- Look out for people working under cars
- If the vehicle is high risk, consider marking the metal shell of the converter with a unique mark, so that if it is removed by thieves it will be easier to trace back to your vehicle. Various marking methods are commercially available.
- If you operate a small fleet, consider obstructing access to vehicles with high ground clearance, by parking lower vehicles close by

If you have any information that may assist police, call 101. In an emergency or where immediate response is required always call 999.

Your SNT officers do hold catalytic converter marking sessions and these are published on our website, The next session will be a closed session held on RAF Lakenheath due to the high volume of Honda's owned by USAF personnel.
