FUTURE EVENTS

Wednesday 15th March 2017 - Police and Parish Forum - 19:30 - Claydon Village Hall

The Police/Parish Forum is an opportunity for representatives from each Parish Council as well as members of the public to meet with a member of the SNT and discuss any issues or concerns they may have. This meeting is a valuable opportunity to discuss community safety matters in the Hadleigh area, network with representatives from adjacent villages and the information provided is then used when deciding on the team priorities.

Tuesday 14th March 2017 - Community Engagement event - Shotley.

This is the first community engagement event being run by Hadleigh SNT this year. It will be an opportunity for residents and people in the local area to come and meet the team and discuss any issues/concerns they may have. FURTHER INFORMATION

Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

During February the SNT have dealt with a couple of crime series in the area, both in Shotley and Semer and the surrounding villages. These offences have mainly been burglaries to out buildings overnight. Local officers have made contact with residents affected and offered personal crime prevention advice and are urging everyone to be vigilant and report anything suspicious to police on either 999 or 101.

Regarding the burglaries in Shotley, police are gathering intelligence on who is responsible and have carried out a warrant at an address in Ipswich.

The SNT will be holding their first community engagement this year in Shotley on 14th March 2017 from 11:00-14:00 at the village Hall. This is an opportunity for residents and other local people to speak to the team about any concerns or issues that they may have. There will be further events planned at other locations so please watch this space to see when the team will be coming to your area.

Officers are beginning youth forums in schools to allow young people to meet local officers to discuss any problems and to look at what activities they would like to see in their area to try and reduce incidents of ASB. Mygo is a youth employment service for 16-24 year olds looking for jobs, training or education and officers have conducted a joint patrols around the area trying to identify young people who may benefit from their services. This has proved very useful in the past and these patrols will be conducted on a fairly regular basis.

The Safer Neighbourhood team are also working with the district council to try and resolve ASB problems between residents. These incidents have had a negative impact on the community and are a significant demand on police resources.

I would be keen to hear from any members of the community with any police related issues which they wish to discuss and will be attending the next Parish Forum meeting on 15th March. In the meantime I can be contacted via phone on 101 or e-mail the team at HadleighSNT@suffolk.pnn.police.uk.
