Wednesday 10th May 2017 - Annual Police and Parish Forum - 19:30 - Hadleigh Leisure Centre

The Police/Parish Forum is an opportunity for representatives from each Parish Council as well as members of the public to meet with a member of the SNT and discuss any issues or concerns they may have. This meeting is a valuable opportunity to discuss community safety matters in the Hadleigh area, network with representatives from adjacent villages and the information provided is then used when deciding on the team priorities.



FURTHER INFORMATION

Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

During April the SNT have been made aware of issues of littering, drug taking and general anti social behaviour in both Hadleigh and Claydon. The team are working with the Porch Project which is a youth group in Hadleigh to try and address these issues ahead of the summer period. I would urge anyone who witnesses any form of anti social behaviour to report this to the police as this will help build a picture of when and where the problems are happening so that the team can request extra resources to try and tackle and resolve the problem. Without this information we may not be focussing our patrols in the right area and therefore missing opportunities of intervention.

The SNT have completed a number of inputs at schools throughout the area on varying topics such as Child sexual exploitation, staying safe on social media and Road safety. These have been well received and after these inputs officers have then had a chance to speak with the youths who have provided valuable information regarding current investigations the team are dealing with.

The SNT held their last engagement event in Pinewood and during this event members of the team responded to complaints of parking in some of the residential roads around Suffolk One. The team are currently working with the college and Suffolk County council on educating the students on appropriate parking and will also take enforcement action if cars are parked illegally.

The team are also monitoring offenders within the area and ensuring that they are dealt with promptly to reduce further chances of re-offending. Where appropriate Community protection notices are being sought which places conditions on individuals and can result in arrest and prosecution.

The Safer Neighbourhood team are still working with the district council to try and resolve ASB problems between residents. These incidents have had a negative impact on the community and are a significant demand on police resources. The team are also constantly reviewing and trying to develop intelligence in order to obtain warrants from the court. If you wish to report any suspicious activity then please get in touch as this may provide us with enough intelligence to take further action
