Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT. This is the first report following the organisational changes instigated by the Suffolk local policing review. In future reports it is anticipated that figures will be available in order to keep you informed of the number of incidents received/reported as well as a break down of the crimes reported in the 6 key priority areas. Further statistical information about crimes in your local area can be obtained from the Police.Com website. Interested parties are also encouraged to sign up to Police Connect which will provide information via text message more frequently.

The new team will be based at Hadleigh and cover the 49 parishes listed below. The officers will no longer have work specific to individual parishes but instead their work will be role specific for the whole area. The roles will focus officers on addressing problems in a number of areas such as anti-social behavior, Retail and Licensing issues, Crime reduction, Mental health, Domestic violence and Schools and young people. It is anticipated that by specialising in these specific areas of work the officers will be able to focus more time on the problems and become more proficient in dealing with them.

The further information area will be used to highlight current crime trends and give information about things to be aware of or watch out for in order to minimise crime and disorder and promote information to help prevent and detect crime.
