WE DID...

1. We held a well attended multi-agency event in Barnard Square, whereby a number of agencies were able to provide support and advice to a number of residents.
2. Continuous work with our partner agencies to reduce the drug related ASB in Alderman Park. High visibility patrols have been conducted in the area, resulting in persons encountered and dealt with accordingly.
3. We have been working with our partner agencies to deal with the main offenders of ASB in the Whitehouse Area. We are looking to take positive action against anyone causing issues and arrests have already been made.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Bridge Ward: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 115 investigations were recorded.

One burglary where a shed had been broken into, however nothing was stolen. There have been four theft from motor vehicles, one interference with a motor vehicle and one theft of motor vehicle. Two pedal cycles have been stolen. Five persons have been dealt with for being in possession of a controlled drug.

Gipping Ward: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 145 investigations were recorded.

Three dwelling burglaries; one person has been identified as being responsible for one of the burglaries and is currently being sought by Police. Two sheds have been broken into and a bike has been stolen. There have been three theft from motor vehicles and one theft of motor vehicle. There have been two robberies reported and two people have been arrested.

Stoke Park: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 85 investigations were recorded.

One dwelling burglary and one attempted dwelling burglary. A garage was broken into and a bike was stolen. There have been six thefts from motor vehicles and one theft of motor vehicle. One robbery has also been recorded where some money was taken.

Sprites: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 76 investigations were recorded.

One dwelling burglary, a person has been identified as being responsible and is currently being sought by Police. Two garages and a shed have been broken into. There have been seven thefts from motor vehicles. One person has been dealt with for being in possession of a controlled drug.

Castle Hill: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 42 investigations were recorded.

There was one attempted burglary dwelling. Four motor vehicles were broken into and there was one theft of motor vehicle. One person has been arrested and charged for being in possession of a Class A drug.

Whitehouse: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 79 investigations were recorded.

Two dwelling burglaries have been reported. Two business properties have been broken into and money stolen. There have been two thefts from motor vehicles, three theft of motor vehicles and one theft of pedal cycle. There was also an arson reported where damage was caused to some play equipment.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Whitton: Between 01/08/2016 and 30/07/2016 a total of 70 investigations were recorded.

There have been two robberies reported, during which a mobile phone has been stolen. There have been two thefts from motor vehicles and two pedal cycles have been stolen.
