FURTHER INFORMATION

Between 1st - 31st January 2017 there have been 306 incidents and 101 investigations within the 6 wards that make up the Mildenhall SNT area. Many of the investigations relate to theft, damage, minor assaults without injury along with adult/child and mental health referrals. Figures below relate to crime categories from the Police and Crime Plan only.

This months editions is given over to the Forest Heath Volunteer Police Cadets unit, which launched on 28th May 2016 and recruits young people in the Forest Heath area.

The aims of the scheme are:

- to promote and encourage a practical interest in policing / emergency services work among young people
- to provide training which will encourage positive leadership within communities
- to encourage the spirit of adventure and develop qualities of leadership and good citizenship.

Current cadet units

There are currently nine cadet units, which are based in Martlesham, Ipswich, Bury St Edmunds, Lowestoft, Sudbury, Haverhill, Mildenhall, Stowmarket and Beccles. Young people who want to join one of these units must live in the area of the group they wish to join.

During the first 12-month period, cadets will follow a training and development programme.
