# FURTHER INFORMATION

Mildenhall Safer Neighbourhood Team area has had 115 investigations recorded during May. Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into child and adult protection (safeguarding), mental health and anti social behaviour.

Iceni has had 1 investigations recorded; this was in relation to child abduction

Manor has had 9 investigations recorded; these have included public order, assault, attempted burglary, theft, malicious communications and domestic abuse

Market has had 29 investigations recorded; these have included theft, domestic abuse, damage, assault, public order, burglary and a number of safeguarding investigations

Red Lodge has had 30 investigation recorded; these have included domestic abuse, theft, damage and a number of safeguarding and asb investigations

South has had 9 investigations recorded; these have included theft, damage, assault and public order

Great Heath has had 34 investigation recorded; these have included domestic abuse, damage, theft, harassment, malicious communications, assault, burglary, drugs and a number of safeguarding and asb investigations.

Generally no one crime type has been more prevalent than another but with the lighter and warmer days and nights we urge everyone to take care of their property by following these simple security steps:

- \*Ensure doors and windows are locked - even if you are popping out for a minute
- \*Fit key operated locks to windows
- \*Ensure garden tools and ladders are locked away
- \*Lock your shed and garage
- \*Timer switches can be used to switch lights/radios on and off to make your home appear occupied
- \*Security mark your valuables with your postcode (marking kits are available from your local SNT)
- \*Do not keep large amounts of money in your home

# FURTHER INFORMATION

"Now that the new model of delivering your local policing is 3 months old we wanted to remind you of the many ways you can get in touch with us. Most importantly, if it's an emergency always ring 999. However, if it's not an emergency but you wish to report a crime or a concern for safety then use 101. If you simply wish to contact your local team, perhaps to tell us about Anti-Social Behavior (ASB) or a series of crimes occurring in your area, or to tell us about your concerns about how the police have handled a local community matter, why not in the first instance speak with your local Inspector and discuss the matter with them?"

Your local Inspector will be able to review the matter and make an assessment about how well we did, reporting back to you with their findings. Your local community inspector is Inspector Mark Shipton.

If you want to speak to your local officer and it's not urgent then an email will be quickest means to get in contact, and if you need a reply then a member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs.

Remember, the demand on 101 is very high and if you don't need to report a crime we would encourage the use of email.

Finally, our brand new and interactive website will be on-line in the Autumn which will give you direct access to your teams in a fast, secure format, as well as providing loads of really useful information!"
