## Whitehouse

There has been an increase in the amount of drug paraphenalia being located within the Bramford Lane Rec. Your Local SNT are increasing their patrols and working with partner agencies to resolve this matter, identify those responsible and deal with them robustly.

On-Going reports of Anti-Social Behavior from residents in the new properties behind Ulster Avenue Shops Your Local SNT are working with housing providers to identify the premises causing Anti-Social Behavior and address these concerns

## Whitton

There has been an increase in suspicious activity around the old bats and ball cricket stadium.

Your local SNT are patrolling the area to educate youths still trying to get into the site as there is a health and safety risk.

## Castle Hill

There has been concerns around speeding in the area of Dale Hall Lane

Your Local SNT are out patrolling and conducting speed checks to tackle this matter.

## Bridge

There has been an increase in drug related ASB in the Jamestown Boulevard area. Your local SNT have increased patrols in the area and are developing intelligence to target those involved.

## Gipping

There has been an increase in anti-social behaviour (ASB) in Lavender Hill. Your local SNT are patrolling the area to reassure local residents and identify those involved. SNT officers are working in partnership with Ipswich Borough Council to prevent escalation.

## Stoke Park

South West Ipswich SNT have identified motorists driving without insurance or licence and conducted targeted patrols, seizing the vehicles and issuing fixed penalty notices to the drivers. Please continue to report illegal drivers.

You can sign up to Police Connect to receive messages about local crimes, along with useful crime prevention advice.

You can join one of the many watch schemes, including SpeedWatch, Neighbourhood Watch and StreetWatch.
