Welcome to your Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) newsletter from your locality Inspector, Roger Salmon.

This new online newsletter is envisaged to provide ward based statistical information about crime and events, as well as allowing SNT's to comment on projects and issues they are working on.

Your SNT sits within the Southern policing command area. Inside that command unit sits the South East locality for which I am responsible. Three SNT's operate in this locality - Ipswich East, Woodbridge, and Felixstowe. The locality has a boundary defined by parishes in the north including Otley, Charsfield, Campsea-Ashe and Iken, and our southern border defined by the river Orwell. It is a locality that is mainly a large rural area, contrasted with more urban policing environments such as Ipswich and Felixstowe. Each locality presents a unique set of challenges.

The SNT's continue to operate with Sergeants, Police Constables and Police Community Support Officers (PCSO's) and a number of these have policed their localities for many years providing valuable continuity as we move to a different system of working. We are now working more efficiently to make your area, and Suffolk in general a Safe Place to Work Travel and Invest. With the warmer weather approaching, there has been an increase in the theft of pedal cycles. People are reminded to purchase a reasonable lock and be mindful of where your bike is secured. Serial numbers and the like are best recorded someplace safe for investigation and insurance purposes. We would encourage people to visit the immobilise.com website and register any property on the site with a serial number that can be identified. This is a national service where recovered property can be quickly identified as stolen and returned to owners.

A new campaign has been initiated targeting parking outside of schools with regards to child/road safety. Schools can request a safety banner in relation to this for placing on the school gates or railings.

Drug enforcement activity continues and there are a number of addresses in East Ipswich subject to drug activity that we are working on in coordination with our intelligence departments, drug teams, and partners.
