Welcome to your Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) newsletter from your locality Inspector, Roger Salmon.

This new online newsletter is envisaged to provide ward based statistical information about crime and events, as well as allowing SNT's to comment on projects and issues they are working on.

Your SNT sits within the Southern policing command area. Inside that command unit sits the South East locality for which I am responsible. Three SNT's operate in this locality - Ipswich East, Woodbridge, and Felixstowe. The locality has a boundary defined by parishes in the north including Otley, Charsfield, Campsea-Ashe and Iken, and our southern border defined by the river Orwell. It is a locality that is mainly a large rural area, contrasted with more urban policing environments such as Ipswich and Felixstowe. Each locality presents a unique set of challenges.

The SNT's continue to operate with Sergeants, Police Constables and Police Community Support Officers (PCSO's) and a number of these have policed their localities for many years providing valuable continuity as we move to a different system of working. We are now working more efficiently to make your area, and Suffolk in general a Safe Place to Work Travel and Invest. Please continue to report incidents of concern or suspicious behaviour to our control room, either through '101' where the call is non urgent, or 999 in an emergency. # FURTHER INFORMATION

We continue to live in a very safe part of the world.

There has been some burglaries and vehicle crime in rural locations. A number Public houses have been targeted. Our vehicle crime issues are mainly opportunistic thieves, with valuables on show being taken, SAT NAVs, money, wallets. Motorists are advised to secure vehicles overnight and to keep high value items out of view and there is general reminder that securing property including garages, lock ups, doors and windows all go some way to reducing the risk of being a victim of crime. Concern over rise in Anti-Social behaviour in Rendlesham. This includes Friday evenings and with owners of cars playing loud music and revving engines in various locations in the village. We have identified a number of individuals responsible for antisocial behaviour linked to their vehicles, and a number of vehicle seizures have taken place across the area. People are reminded to keep reporting concerns to us, and if possible and safe to do so make a record of the registration plates involved.
