### WE DID...

1. We have increased patrols within the target area and been strengthening our community links by acting promptly on intelligence. We have conducted a recent Street Meet and spoken to residents about their concerns. Suspects are being arrested and prosecuted and social media is being used to publicise this.
2. The SNT are still patrolling and monitoring this area and working with the Baptist Church and partner agencies to tackle this.
3. The SNT have been patrolling around the area of Cambridge drive due to reports of young youths running and jumping onto garages and bin stores, A joint effort with the SNT and local schools have identified the offenders and action has been taken.

Whitton,

88 investigations recorded in the Whitton area. 3x damage to vehicles, 3 x aggravated vehicle taking, 6 x theft of motor vehicles (mainly mopeds) and 2 non dwelling burglaries. Arrests have, and continue to be made, re the moped thefts so keep an eye on our twitter page for updates including the recent charging of a youth for handling stolen mopeds.

Whitehouse

105 investigations recorded by police including, 1 x Robbery, 1 x Dwelling burglary, 4 attempt non-dwelling burglaries, 3 x Theft of Motor Vehicles and 1 x being concerned in the supply of drugs. There were 15 thefts from shops in April too.

Castle Hill.

34 Investigations recorded during April, including 4 x Theft of Motor vehicles(mainly mopeds), 2 x damage to motor vehicles, and 2 x interference with motor vehicles. 1 x bladed article where the offender has been charged to court,1 x Dwelling burglary and 1 x sexual assault

Gipping

142 Investigations recorded in April including 4 x Arson, 5 x Assault ABH, 2 dwelling burglaries, 2 business burglaries and 3 attempted business burglaries. 2 x concerned in the supply of drugs,2 x theft from motor vehicles, 1 Theft of Motor vehicle along with 3 drugs possession offences

Bridge

133 Investigations recored including 2 x taking a vehicle without consent, 2 x rape of a male, 7 x damage to motor vehicles 1x dwelling burglary and 11 assaults causing injuries

Sprites.

65 Investigations recorded including 13 x theft from shops, 2 x assault ABH and 1 x assault on Police with intent to wound, 2 x dwelling Burglary, 6 Damage to motor vehicles and 1 x offensive weapon offence

Stoke Park

89 Investigations have been recorded in this area during April including 7 assaults causing actual bodily harm,3x dwelling burglaries and 2 x business burglaries. There's been 1 x theft of a motor vehicle and 2 x damage to motor vehicles along with 1 x threat to kill and a Racially Aggravated public order offence.

In addition to the 3 arrests made so far re moped thefts, 1 youth has recently been charged with handling stolen mopeds and also been reported to court for aggravated vehicle taking. 4 positive drugs warrants have been carried out on our area by the SNT team working with scorpion and drugs team removing drugs and cash gains as proceeds of crime.
