Responding to issues in your community

The Stowmarket Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) hold weekly meetings and monthly appoint locations for 'High Visibility Patrols' (HVPs) and Priorities. These locations are selected by analysing data, looking at current events and liaising with local residents. This month our HVP's and Priorities are Cedars Park and licensed premises.

Cedars Park - there have been a number of anti social behavior incidents reported to Police. These reports include the anti social use of vehicles and drug use by youths at the Park area.

Licensed Premises - In the lead up to, and during, the World cup, we have carried out visits to establish their intentions during this time, and to offer advice and support, to ensure the Community can enjoy the football.

Making the community safer

On 9th June, we attended Haughley Fete and Beyton fair, giving us an opportunity to engage with members of the community.

On 23rd and 24th June - We turned up at StowFiesta in Stowmarket, to provide a visible presence and engage with the community.

On 29th June, we have attended Woodley School fete to meet members of our community. On the same day we have attended the Cedars Park AGM, to listen to concerns from our community around ASB they are experiencing.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

Concerns raised by residents in Mendlesham village over speeding. We have arranged with our Safety Camera team for a Speed data Recorder (SDR) to be deployed which due to the data received, has now been adopted by our Safecam team, who will now carry out enforcement in the area.

OP Sceptre is an Operation around knife crime in the county, and we have visited local High schools to reinforce the message around carrying knives, and the dangers this leaves people open to.

As our part in Crucial Crew this year ,between 18th June - 26th June, the team visited 'The Mix' each day to engage with Year 6's from around the region to educate them around on-line security and safety.
