WE DID...

- 1- Recent reports have highlighted a return of ASB in this area. Patrols continue in a bid to identify the main protagonists, with one Community Protection Warning Notice already issued to a repeat offender. Engagement with the local residents and businesses continues.
- 2- We have targeted repeated ASB around the cricket ground in Long Melford and built up a picture of low level cannabis use together with minor offending. We continue to target those responsible and have now identified possible vehicles involved. We continue to target these vehicles for drugs and road traffic offence's.

FURTHER INFORMATION

- UPDATE ON CRIME DATA

Crime data is for September 2016. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate.

-The 6 x Dwelling Burglaries include offences that took place in, Newton x 1 / Sudbury East x 1 / Sudbury North x 2 (one attempt) / Bures x 1 and Long Melford x 1 (Attempt). Most of these crimes involved a window being forced or smashed but There is no confirmed pattern or link. They took place on several different days throughout September.

- CURRENT ISSUES

- Vehicle Crime Series - As per recent media reports, in early October 2016, we saw a series of crimes involving the theft of tools from Ford Transit vans in the West of Suffolk (Haverhill in particular). An operation was commissioned to tackle this which saw additional patrols supported by the Western Area pro active team. The SNT undertook crime reduction work.

Unfortunately, on 31st Oct, seven similar offences were reported, mainly in Sudbury . It appears that a device is being used to overcome the central locking system. This operation continues. We ask people to remain vigilant and in the short term to remove valuable tools from vehicles at night. The operation continues.

- We are also aware of around 10 offences in West Suffolk (Three in Sudbury) where Honda cars have had their Catalytic Converters removed over night. Local SNT's occasionally offer a CAT marking service at a local garage to try and prevent such crimes. Sudbury will be holding one on Tuesday 15th November at 0930hours, SE Tyres, Woodhall Business Park.

- CRIME REDUCTION ADVICE

With the dark nights upon us can we please remind homeowners to use timer switches for their lighting, lock and secure sheds and outbuildings, as well as securing tools and other outside equipment that could be used by burglars to assist entry into properties. Further crime reduction advice can be obtained from your SNT.

We would also like to remind cyclists that lights now need to be utilised during these early evenings and ask parents to ensure their children have working lights and the all important cycle helmet.

- OTHER NEWS

Church Lead theft - This issue was highlighted in local media earlier in the year. We have seen three 'Theft of lead' offences from church roofs in Oct 16 within the county. We felt it would be a good time to remind people to keep an eye on their local church and report any suspicious behaviour. Criminals are likely to spend a reasonable amount of time at a church and may look like they are carrying out legitimate work. We would rather receive a call and check them out rather than later find out that an offence had taken place. None of the recent offences have taken place in Sudbury but there was one offence in Polstead.
