WE DID...

- 1- Recent reports have highlighted a return of ASB in this area. Patrols continue in a bid to identify the main protagonists, with one Community Protection Warning Notice already issued to a repeat offender. Engagement with the local residents and businesses continues.
- 2- We have targeted repeated ASB around the cricket ground in Long Melford and built up a picture of low level cannabis use together with minor offending. We continue to target those responsible and have now identified possible vehicles involved. We continue to target these vehicles for drugs and road traffic offences.

- UPDATE ON CRIME DATA

Crime data is for August 2016. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate.

- The 9 x Dwelling Burglaries include offences that took place in, Waldingfield x 1 / Sudbury south x 1 (Suspect known to victim) / Lawshall x 1 / Long Melford x 2 (one was attempt) / Glemsford x 1 / Cockfield x 1 / Great Cornard x 1 (attempt - Suspect known to victim) There is no set pattern to the offence's and they took place on several different days throughout August.

- We would like to reassure you that each day, an operational meeting is held by Suffolk Constabulary to discuss crimes and incidents that have taken place during the previous 24 hours. This meeting is led by a senior officer. If anything is identified that may lead to an immediate risk to the community, a notification would be circulated at that time to those affected. We would not wait until the newsletter to share such information.

- CURRENT ISSUES

Community Protection Warning Notice issued to a company leaving vehicles on the highway for the sole intention of advertising their business. The owner has taken on board the notice and permanently removed the vehicles in order to avoid prosecution.
