Sudbury

You said...

Concerns raised by residents concerning the volume and type of vehicle visiting a small housing development in Bures. The use of these vehicles was causing obstructions in the village and leading to some frustrations between the builders and residents.

We did...

Mediated with residents and the builders to discuss the problems, and to look for solutions. PCSO Mansell was able to make suggestions to both sides and find some level ground. This included a reduction in the number of vehicles visiting the site.

Responding to issues in your community

Following a rise in low level crime and anti social behaviour in Great Cornard, we have worked with our Neighbourhood Response Colleagues to target the key individuals believed to be involved. As a result, we have interviewed a teenage male for a number of offences, and are currently putting him through the Criminal Justice system with a view to him attending Court. We continue to support local businesses in reducing and removing the issues caused by this group of young people connected to their premises.

Making the community safer

The focus of our speed awareness sessions, and enforcement activity has been in Newton Green this month. There has been a very low return of motorists breaching the 30mph speed limit, which is a positive and we will continue to be active in the village to ensure compliance and road safety.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

In the early hours of Monday 19th March, three males forced entry into the Co-Op store in Canhams Road, Great Cornard using crowbars and a pick axe. A significant amount of cigarettes were stolen from the burglary, and the offenders left the scene shortly before Police arrival. Through a fast response, and joint approach with Essex Police, three males were subsequently arrested for the offence just outside of the Sudbury area, and remain under investigation.
