Responding to issues in your community

Welcome to the updated version of our monthly newsletter. Following feedback on the previous document, it was agreed that a change was needed. The general feeling was that our crime data was confusing and contained insufficient detail to be of use. As an organisation, we are moving away from counting of individual crimes and are instead monitoring exceptions to annual trends. This includes both increases and reductions in crime types and ensures that our response to crime trend is measured and proportionate rather than a 'knee jerk' reaction. The news letter will contain information on current crime trends within the locality and provide updates on the work being done to tackle them. Making the community safer

We carried out a targeted operation in sudbury Town centre with Roads Policing and Special Constables looking at drivers using mobile phones. four people were reported for using their phone, 10 drivers for no seatbelt, and one for no insurance. There will be a repeat of this operation but we will look to alter the location to ensure greater coverage.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

We recently tackled a community issue in Great Cornard where a large cross breed dog had been causing a nuisance for several years on and off. It lacked control and was often escaping from its home address. through positive action, and engagement with the community by Police, the owner is now no longer in possession of the dog, and it no longer poses a threat. the Sudbury area has been targeted by unknown thieves in recent weeks, targeting vans and stealing a large number of tools. Please be vigilant, report suspicious behaviour and ensure your vehicles are secure, and contents security marked.
