You said...

Assist a local family with mental and social health care needs to reintegrate with professionals and reduce the risk to them.

We did...

Arranged a multi-agency meeting to gain an understanding on what barriers currently existed, and how we could remove those barriers. We then engaged with the family, worked with partners and accompanied one member of the family to a much needed health appointment. The family are now receiving ongoing professional support.

Responding to issues in your community

We continue to receive reports surrounding Theft from Motor Vehicles, mainly work vans. Thieves have been targeting tools and equipment, PCSOs from Sudbury SNT have been liaising with victims, Parish and Town Councils, the media and the community safety team in order to provide crime reduction advice and encourage residents to: "See it, Hear it, Report it". Please remember, if you are witnessing a crime in progress please don't hesitate to call 999. This will give officers the best opportunity to apprehend the offender.

Tips on how to protect your vehicle:

- Park your vehicle in a secure area i.e. in a garage or behind a locked gate
- If you park it on a driveway, consider installing motion activated lighting and CCTV. Otherwise, park in a well lit, populated area.
- Where possible, empty your vehicle every night and lock your equipment away in a secure place
- Forensic security marking kits are available to mark your property and parts on your vehicle
- Fit vehicle security equipment within your vehicle
- Use high visibility signage to deter thieves by stating that no valuables are stored in the van overnight
- Be aware of people acting suspiciously nearby

By increasing our intelligence profile surrounding a suspected drug supplier, we have managed to limit their opportunities to inflict class A drugs on others as well as issuing them a Community Protection Warning Notice that will safeguard our young, vulnerable groups in the Sudbury Area.
