Responding to issues in your community

During the month of October there were a total of 253 investigations in Woodbridge. This is a decrease from August 2018 where we recorded 289 investigations. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Parishes have been affected by, residential / garage / shed burglaries, thefts from motor vehicles, criminal damage and ASB incidents. Investigations also include reassurance and crime reduction surveys.

Operation Lunar is still in place. There will be increased patrols over Suffolk to reduce Anti Social Behaviour during Halloween and Bonfire Night.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB
