### WE DID...

Carried out speed monitoring in variety of locations using both speed camera and speed indicating device. Worked with and supported Community Speed Watch schemes in operation on the district. In June, 153 vehicles surveyed speeding by volunteers in your community were processed under the speedwatch scheme.

Carried out, as often as possible, patrols of hotspots for parking offences giving advice or issuing fixed penalty notices. The Special Constabulary have also contributed and patrolled areas, issuing tickets as necessary. 22 fixed penalty notices issued since initiative to carry out increased number of enforcement sessions recently.

Continued to work with partners to address concerns of ASB use of vehicles around Martlesham and Woodbridge using patrols and ASB legislation. To date we have sent out over 40 warning letters and extra patrols being planned as part of Op Parkland.

#### CURRENT PRIORITIES

At the latest tasking meeting held on 16th March 2017, priorities set for Woodbridge SNT are:

- Working with partners to address complaints of anti-social use of vehicles in Martlesham and Woodbridge in particular.
- Ensuring a young female receives support following extensive demand on service.
- Investigate and address, dog complaints and related investigations in Hollesley area

#### NEVER LEAVE AN OPEN INVITE

Residents are being advised to 'Close it, Lock it, Check it' and be vigilant with their home security to help keep burglars at bay.

Please make sure you remain vigilant with your home security:

- Keep your doors locked at all times, even when you are in the house.
- Keep windows locked especially at night and when you go out, especially vulnerable windows such as those down stairs.
- Do not leave any keys in locks or close to doors or windows. Make sure you have a fire plan so you can get out in the case of a fire.
- Check your garden to ensure there is nothing that could be used to force entry with. i.e. tools/ masonry
- Keep back gates locked and make sure that there is nothing that could be used to climb over with, such as a wheelie bin.
- Register your valuables for free at [www.immobilise.com](http://www.immobilise.com) If recovered by police they can be returned to you and registration may assist in a prosecution and deterring crime.
- Report anything suspicious immediately on 101 or 999 in an emergency.

Remember, Close it, Lock it, Check it.

#### WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR AREA?

WOODBIDGE WARD - One report of ASB relating to youths being a nuisance inside a house renovation.

Woodbridge - 4 Burglaries (2 business entry forced, tools and jewellery taken - 2 residential (metals stolen from house renovation and garage forced with bikes stolen), an exposure by a man in a van - Enquiries exhausted an unfortunately didn't identify suspect, 3 incidents of damage (toilets in Elmhurst park, a grave headstone that may be family dispute related, sensor light damaged on a house), 5 Damages to vehicles that were all scratched in one location, 2 reports of theft - number plates from a car and some lead flashing from a building close to Market Hill.

Hasketon - 1 Business burglary where property forced, damage caused and some fuel stolen

Nothing to report for Great and Little Bealings

MELTON WARD - Two reports of ASB - 1 in Melton with youths breaking tree branches and throwing them around in road, and 1 at Rock Barracks where a youth has been seen kicking a fence and swearing

Melton - 1 burglary of a garage that was forced and a cycle stolen, A number of vehicle related crimes that include Cash and laptop taken from two vehicles, 1 was entered and searched and damaged, an attempt was made to steal a vehicle whilst one was successfully stolen and found in Ipswich - Enquiries are continuing as to a potential suspect.

IT IS IMPERATIVE TO ENSURE YOUR VEHICLE IS SECURE AND VALUABLES REMOVED TO REDUCE THE CHANCES OF THIS OPPORTUNIST CRIME

Bromeswell - 1 incident of theft of heating oil - ADVICE AVAILABLE FROM SNT ABOUT INCREASING SECURITY OF CONTAINERS, 1 exposure report on river bank - nobody identified.

Ufford - 1 Robbery allegation - 3 youths trying to take a dog unsuccessfully, enquiries haven't revealed any suspects.

Rock Barracks - 1 criminal damage - heavy items thrown through window of property.

## WHATS HAPPENING ON YOUR WARD...

WICKHAM MARKET WARD - 4 ASB related reports regarding drug dealing - currently being investigated and assessed for further action.

Wickham Mkt - 1 theft of a motor cycle

Nothing to report for Dallinghoo, Charsfield and Pettistree

RENDELSHAM WARD - No reports of ASB on this ward

Rendlesham - 1 offence of damage where vehicle has been scratched.

DEBEN WARD - 1 report of ASB - vehicles driving erratically in East Lane Car park Bawdsey

Hollesley - 2 Burglary reports (1 residential outbuilding where tools have been stolen, and 1 business premises where alcohol and cigarettes were taken. Arrests made in relation to the latter)

1 vehicle had a window smashed.

Boyton - Attempted burglary of a house boat but suspects disturbed and left.

nothing to report for Alderton, Bawdsey, Shottisham, Ramsholt and Sutton Village.

MARTLESHAM - 10 ASB related reports - 9 regarding vehicles and manner of driving and 1 regarding youths and drugs near to the control tower.

Martlesham - 2 criminal damages (1 relating to a light column at the community centre and 1 where the box containing defibrillator has been damaged but equipment untouched.

ORFORD & EYKE - No reports of ASB on this ward

Orford - Burglary of an outbuilding and cycle stolen

Tunstall - Burglary of an outbuilding over period of a year - tools stolen

Blaxhall - Burglary of an outbuilding, tools stolen.

Butley - Theft - Red diesel taken from plant machinery working in area.

Nothing to report for Eyke, Gedgrave, Sudbourne, Iken, Campsea Ashe, Wantisden, Chillesford, Capel St. Andrew or Snape Maltings.

GRUNDISBURGH - No reports of ASB on this ward

Otley - Burglary of business yard and wood and metals taken.

Grundisburgh - Sheep worried by dog - matter resolved, identity established

Nothing to report for Bredfield, Boulge, Burgh, Culpho, Clopton, or Debach

FYNN VALLEY - No reports of ASB on this ward

Witnesham - 3 burglaries of outbuildings - forced with nothing taken in one, tools and a moped from the other two, 1 vehicle entered by force and cash stolen

Rushmere - 4 vehicles entered through a mix of insecurity and force with searches taken place and cash and cards stolen from 2, nothing from the other 2.

Westerfield - 1 insecure vehicle entered and searched.

Investigating officers continue with enquiries in relation to burglaries, developing information and processing gathered evidence, determining any connections and whether small groups or individuals may be responsible for many of the offences.

MANY OFFENCES ARE OPPORTUNIST AND AS A RESULT OF INSECURITY OR VALUABLES LEFT ON DISPLAY. REDUCE THE CHANCES OF BEING A VICTIM OF CRIME - HAVE A READ OF AVAILABLE INFORMATION. PLEASE REPORT ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS AND IF NOTHING ELSE ABOUT AN ENCOUNTER, OBTAIN REGISTRATION NUMBERS OF VEHICLES.

The effectiveness of investing in home security has recently been highlighted in Bury St Edmunds in an attempted burglary that has resulted in the arrest of a prolific burglar. The home owner in question had fitted a video enabled door bell. This sent a message to his phone alerting them that someone was at the his door of his house and streamed a video of the person, in this case trying to break in. The police were alerted and on viewing the video footage were able to identify the offender and make an arrest.

THE DISPARITY IN NUMBERS OF INVESTIGATIONS WILL BE MADE UP OF AGENCY REFERRALS, REPORTING OF HISTORICAL MATTERS AND SUCH CALLS AS DOMESTIC INCIDENTS. ALL INVESTIGATIONS OF NOTE REQUIRING THE COMMUNITIES ATTENTION OR HELP WILL BE BROUGHT TO THEIR ATTENTION THROUGH MANY MEDIUMS.

THE WOODBRIDGE SNT COVERS POLICE HEADQUARTERS, THAT WILL INEVITABLY LEAD TO A HIGH NUMBER OF INCIDENTS RECEIVED AS COMPLAINTS, REQUESTS FROM OTHER POLICE FORCES AND MATTERS ARISING FROM POLICE CUSTODY WILL ALL BE LOGGED ON THIS AREA.

ON THIS REPORT, ASB CALLS REFER TO ASB THAT CONCERNS THE COMMUNITY. THAT IS GROUPS OF PEOPLE, VEHICLES & LOUD MUSIC RESULTING IN LITTER FOR EXAMPLE AND NOT SUCH THINGS AS NEIGHBOUR DISPUTES THAT ARE LABELLED AS ASB
