Responding to issues in your community

During the month of February, there were a total of 264 investigations in Woodbridge. This is a slight decrease from January where we recorded 265 investigations. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Parishes have been affected by, residential / garage / shed burglaries, thefts from motor vehicles, criminal damage and ASB incidents. Investigations also include reassurance and crime reduction surveys.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

We provided regular foot patrols of Woodbridge Town centre and in particular the Library due to recent ASB occurring there. Our team continue to provide a mobile and foot presence in and around the 'hot spot' areas where crime and ASB is occurring. We work closely with our partner agencies. i.e. SCDC ASB Team and Local Housing Authorities to provide advice and support to victims of crime and those affected by the ASB.
